

Dalata checks into London with first Maldron Hotel

Maldron Hotel Finsbury Park is the first of five new UK hotels for the popular brand over the next 12 months

Dalata Hotel Group, which also operates Clayton Hotels, purchased the ready-to-open 191-bedroom hotel at Finsbury Park for £44.3million and immediately invested a further £4.1 million to meet Maldron Hotels' exacting standards.

Maldron Hotel Finsbury Park General Manager, Kirsty Monington said the hotel is the perfect basecamp for enjoying both the local area and all of London's world-famous attractions and landmarks.

Kirsty said: "We are proud to add to the area's growing reputation as a destination suburb. Following a successful partial opening in July we are now up to full capacity and looking forward to welcoming even more guests.

"Located on Seven Sisters Road and just a one-minute walk from the tube station, providing direct access to the Victoria Line, Piccadilly Line and Thameslink and within easy reach of Euston Station, Kings Cross Station & St. Pancras International, guests are in an ideal location for accessing London & the cities top attractions.

"These excellent transport links also make the hotel a great location for anyone visiting London for business or touring with friends or family.

"For football fans, Maldron Hotel Finsbury Park is also the perfect choice, just a short distance from Arsenal's Emirates Stadium, while the Tottenham Hotspur Stadium is also nearby.

"Finsbury Park is just a five-minute walk away from the hotel and hosts some of London's biggest concerts and festivals with headliners such as The 1975 and Pulp haven taken to the stage in recently.

"Given how accessible we are to central London, Maldron Hotel Finsbury Park really does provide a cost-effective alternative to city centre pricing."

The newly opened hotel has a contemporary ground floor lobby with a spacious dining and bar area, and a well-equipped fitness suite. Maldron Hotel Finsbury Park also boasts comfortable and stylish rooms, including deluxe double-double bedrooms, all complete with rainfall showers, modern wood floors, air-conditioning, and USB charge points.

"Elsewhere the company is in expansion mode with an exciting pipeline in prime locations throughout the UK, Ireland & Continental Europe having recently acquired a landmark hotel in Amsterdam."
